

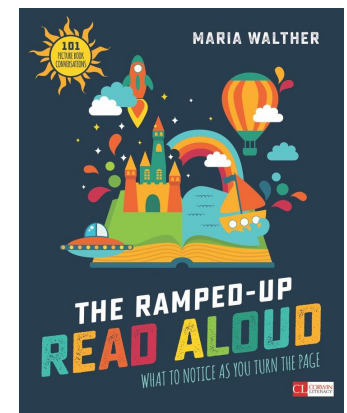

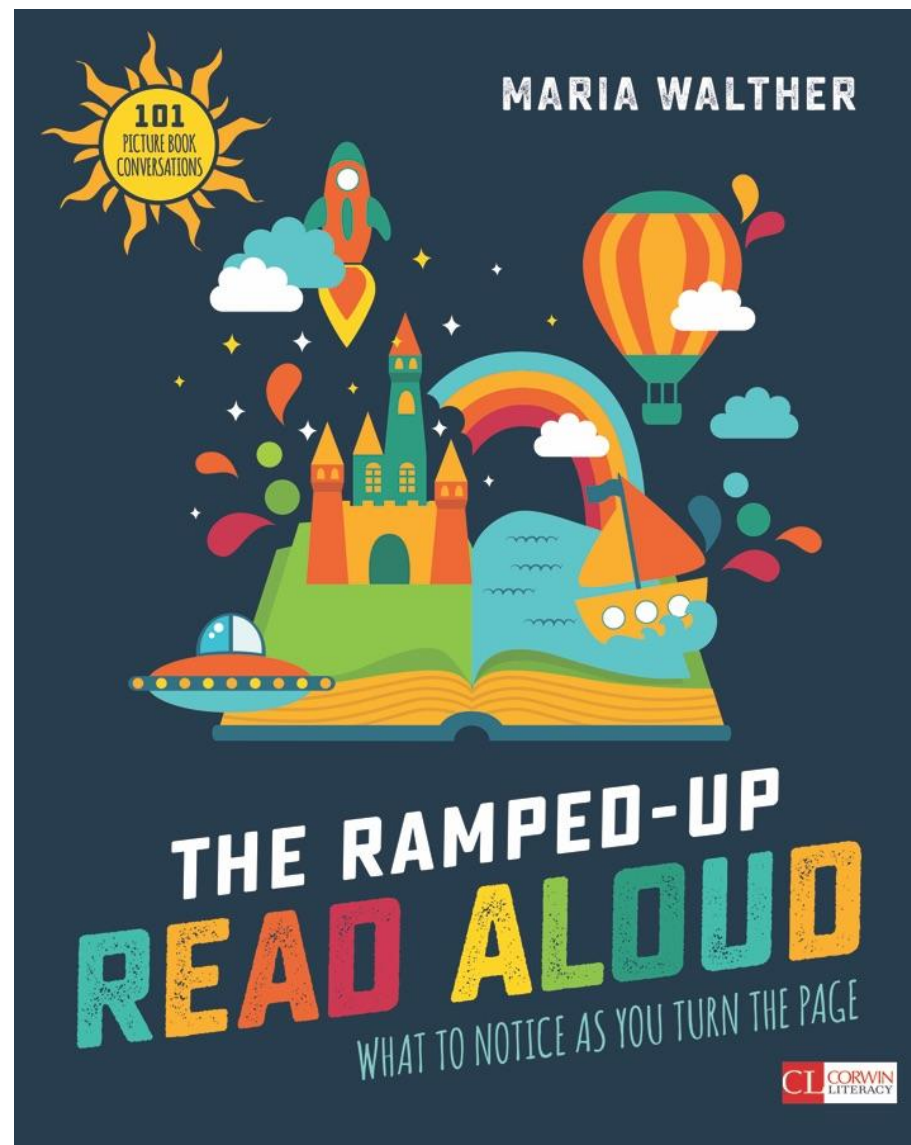

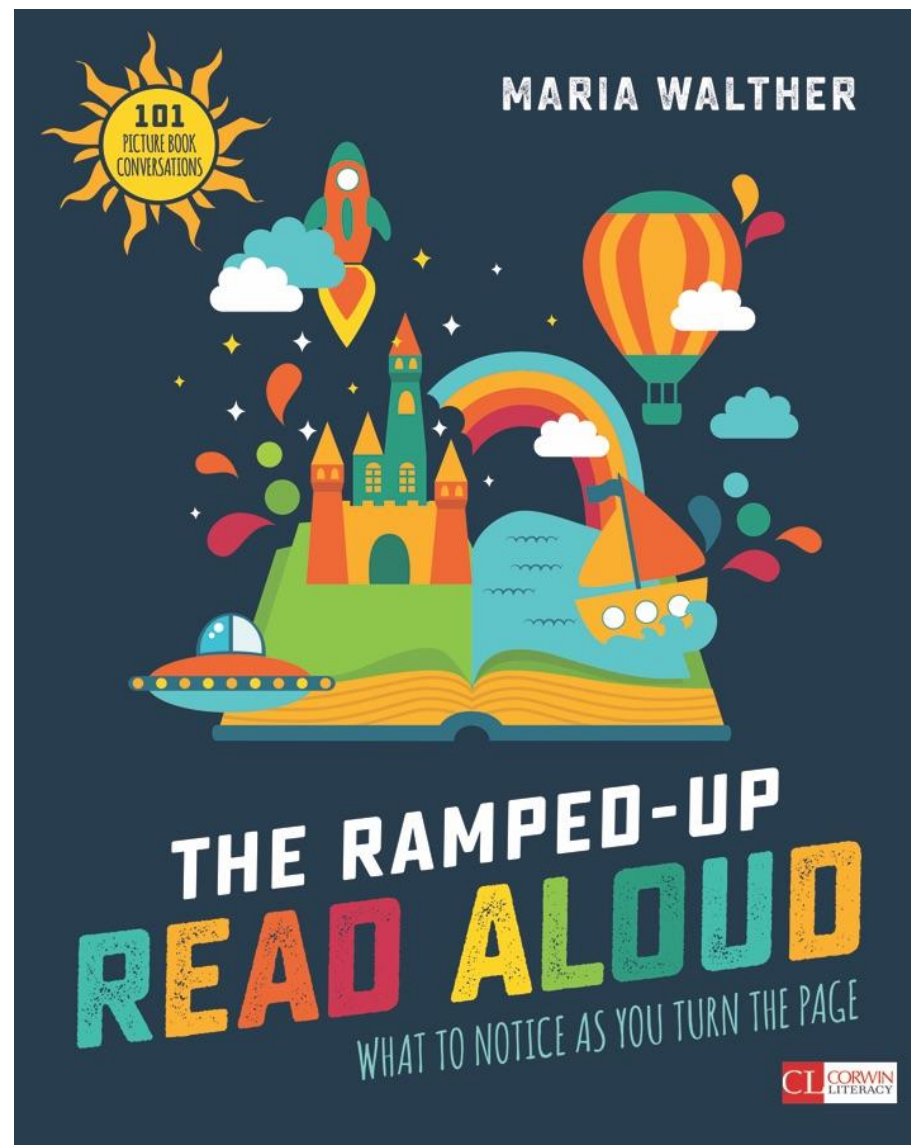
After the read aloud experience, display the words on a bulletin board or in a pocket chart affixed to the wall.
